## ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT



**T**he year 2015 had its share of events; celebrations held within and outside the centre, visitors, volunteers, trainings and fund raising programmes.

As usual the three main festivities; namely Chinese New Year, Hari Raya Puasa and Deepavali were celebrated with much funfare. There were game stations, performances from students, teachers and parents and "MAKAN". The centre held its first Christmas celebration before the school break in November.

Staff, parents, students and their siblings went on a day's outing to Balai Seni Alor Star to visit the Petro Sains Dino Trek on 13 March 2015. Three bus loads of about 120 people left from Penang at 7.30am and returned at about 4pm later in the afternoon. We had breakfast at the Gurun Recreation and Rest station. We stopped for lunch at the Recreational Park in Sungai Petani.

Our annual Sports Day event was held on 24 April 2015. Our patron Tuan Yang Terutama Yang Di-Pertua graced the occasion. The Management Committee, staff and parents of the centre paid their last respects to the late Ms Ong Siew Guat, who died very suddenly upon her return from an overseas trip on 1<sup>st</sup> November 2015.
